



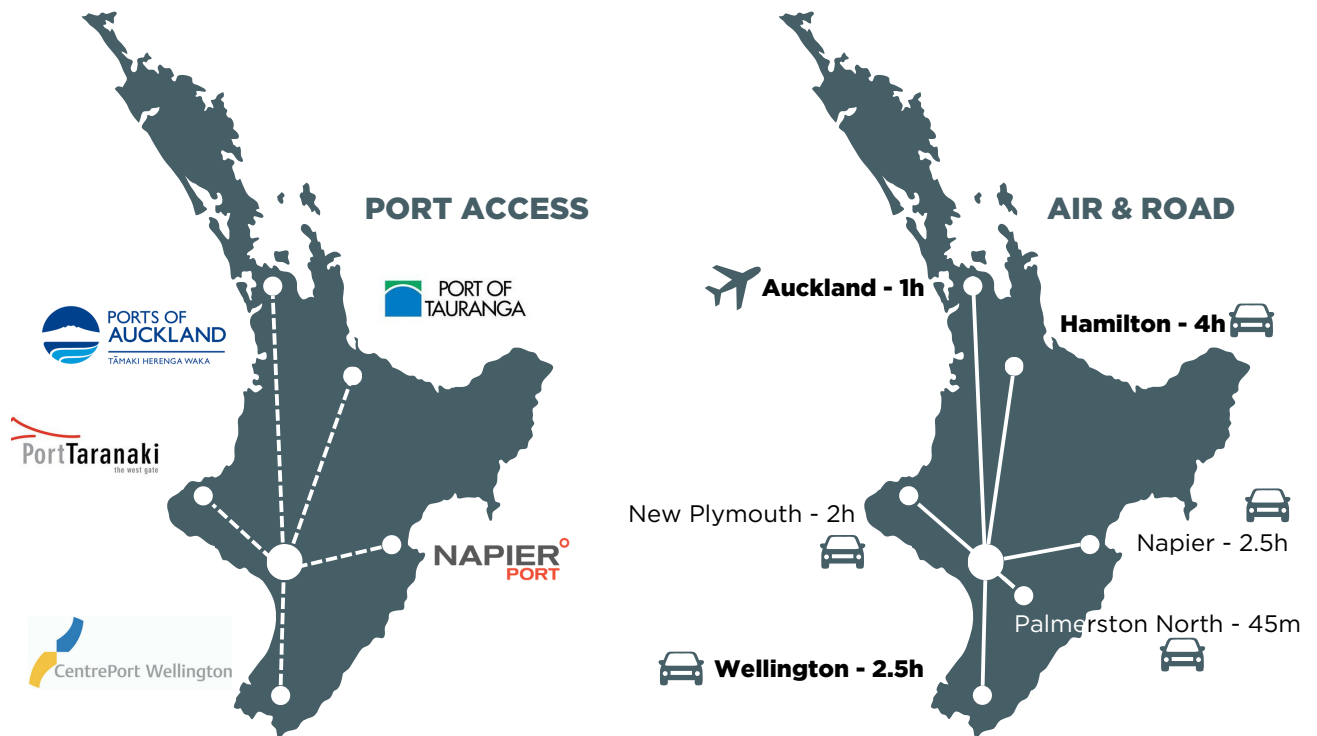
# DOING BUSINESS IN NZ'S UNESCO CITY OF DESIGN

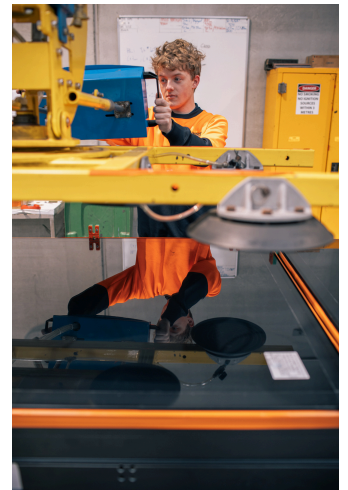

The designation earns Whanganui a place in the UNESCO Creative Cities Network and recognises the city's historic and contemporary contributions to design in innumerable and varied forms.



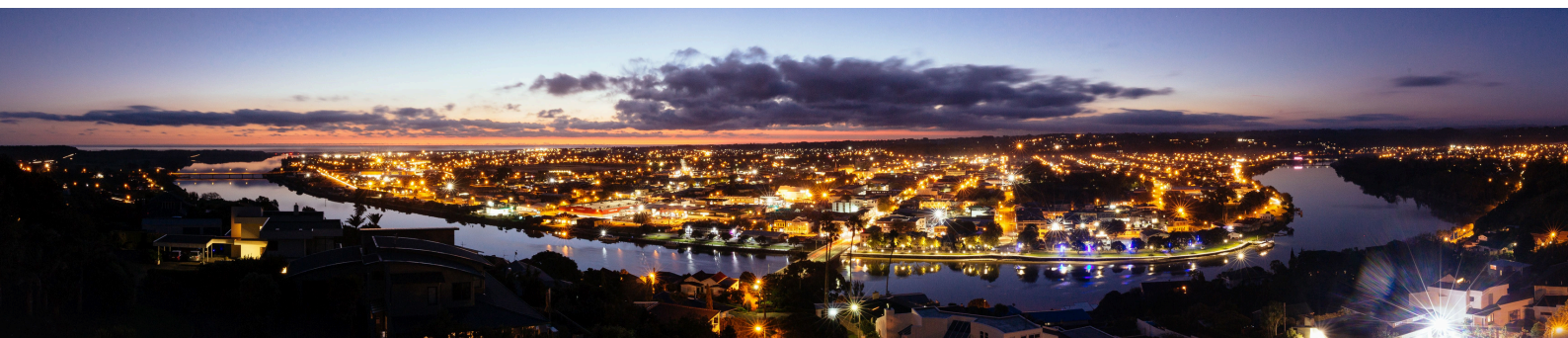
## Leading both economic and social development

In 2023, Whanganui was named a Smart21 City by America-based think tank the Intelligent Community Forum. Whanganui has been awarded the status for the past eight years and is the only New Zealand city to retain its place on the list.
